

Visiting Observer ship in Hand Surgery: Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston, MA

1. Application open to Orthopedic and Plastic Surgeons, interested in learning advanced techniques in surgery of the hand and upper limb.

2. Qualifications to apply:

Applicant should ideally be within the first 10 years of practice.
Applicant should be familiar with the practice of hand surgery and it should form at least 50% of their current practice.

3. Funding: The applicant will be partly funded. Successful applicants will be expected to arrange for the remainder of the funding on their own.

4. How to apply:

Please submit your CV and a letter to interest to Drs. Kalamdani/ Dr. Revankar / Dr. Bhat via email at the email id's provided below.

Applicants will be short listed for interviews to be conducted in Manipal, during the 3rd Annual Indo-US Hand Surgery Conference, February 28-29, 2020.

Short listed applicants will be informed approximately 4 weeks prior to the interview date.

Applicants who will be interviewed will be expected to make their own travel and stay arrangements for the interview.

The successful applicant will be contacted within 4 weeks after the interview.

5. Duration and timing of observership:

The applicant will spend 3 months at the MGH in Boston under the mentorship of Chaitanya Mudgal MD. The timing of the observership will be at a mutually convenient time for the applicant and mentor.

6. Expectations of the successful applicant:

Applicant will be expected to keep a detailed log of operative procedures observed.

Applicant will be expected to keep a photographic log of clinical cases and surgical procedures.

Upon his or her return to India, the applicant will be expected to prepare a written report of their experience, which will be submitted to the selection committee within 30 days of their return to India. Applicants will be expected to make an oral presentation of 10 minutes at the next Indo-US Hand Surgery Conference.

It is expected that upon their return to India, applicants will remain active in Hand Surgery education and adopt leadership roles in this aspect.
