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Abstract:

The main body of the abstract, limited to 300 words, should be written in Times New Roman, 12 pt, justified, single-spaced and include the following elements: a brief background or purpose highlighting the context and significance of the work in relation to the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs); a concise description of the methodology or approach used; the key findings or outcomes; and the main conclusions or implications for practice, policy, or further research. At the end of the abstract, authors should include 3–5 keywords in italics, separated by commas. Submissions must explicitly mention the specific SDG(s) addressed (for example, SDG 3 – Good Health and Well-being or SDG 13 – Climate Action). Abstracts should be original and unpublished, prepared in MS Word (.docx) format, with 1-inch margins on all sides. Title to be in Times New Roman, 14 pt Bold, single spaced.
