# ABSTRACT

## GENERAL SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

### ABSTRACT:

- Should not exceed **250** words.
- Original research papers, case reports, review papers are accepted
- An abstract can be submitted either for paper or poster presentation

### ABSTRACT HEADINGS:

- a) Title
- b) Authors list with affiliation, conference registration ID, email and phone numbers
- c) Name of the presenting author (only for paper presentation)
- d) Faculty guide with affiliation and contact information
- e) Category
- f) Abstract

### ABSTRACT FORMAT:

- a) Original Research: Objective, Methodology, Result, Conclusion
- b) Case Report: Introduction, Case Description, Conclusion
- c) Review Article: Objective, Summary, Conclusion

### CATEGORIES:

1. Oral Surgery, Oral Medicine & Radiology, Oral Pathology
  2. Prosthodontics, Periodontology, Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics and Material sciences
  3. Pedodontics, Orthodontics, Public Health Dentistry
  4. Others: including but not limited to dental education, dental practice management, interprofessional education, practice & care (IPECP), health informatics, service delivery, patient education, social media or other relevant subjects not categorized in previous domains.
- Abstract Submission: to be done through appropriate link provided for paper and poster presentation.
  - Submission of abstracts by email will not be accepted
  - The status of abstract acceptance will be communicated to delegates via their registered email address
  - Upon acceptance, the presentation must be emailed to [srf.mcodsmlr@manipal.edu](mailto:srf.mcodsmlr@manipal.edu)
  - A plagiarism similarity report of less than 15% must be submitted after abstract acceptance along with the final paper

# PAPER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

## AUTHORSHIP & ELIGIBILITY

- A maximum of three participants may co-author a paper.
- Participants must belong to the same institution.
- All participants and co-authors must be registered for the conference to be eligible for presentation
- Each submission must have one faculty from the same institution as guide.

## PRESENTATION & CERTIFICATE

- All authors to be present at the venue (for onsite delegates) or online meeting room (for online delegates) during the given presentation slot
- All authors will receive credit on the same certificate.

## RULES

- A team of maximum 3 delegates for paper presentation.
- Only 1 participant from each team will present the paper.
- Presentation duration: 6 minutes presentation + 2 minutes Q & A (Total 8 minutes).
- Final presentation should be submitted in .pptx format through the link provided on the website.
- A plagiarism report must be mandatorily submitted upon acceptance of the abstract to [srf.mcodsmlr@manipal.edu](mailto:srf.mcodsmlr@manipal.edu).
- Only the conference registration number of the presenter and the co-author should be mentioned in the top right corner, in the order of authorship.
- Name, college name or affiliation must **NOT** be mentioned on the submitted presentation to ensure unbiased evaluation.

- The status of abstract acceptance will be communicated to delegates via their registered email address.

# E-POSTER GUIDELINES

## **AUTHORSHIP & ELIGIBILITY**

- A maximum of 3 participants may be co-authors of the poster
- Participants must belong to the same institution.
- All co-authors must be registered for the conference to be eligible for participation
- Participants may be co-authors in up to three posters.
- Each submission must have one faculty from the same institution as guide.

## **E-POSTER REQUIREMENTS**

- Only single slide presentations are allowed.
- Poster Dimensions: 16:9 Landscape
- Final Poster should be submitted in .pdf format
- Only the conference registration number of the presenter and the co-author should be mentioned in the top right corner, in the order of authorship.
- Name, college name or affiliation must NOT be mentioned on the submitted presentation to ensure unbiased evaluation.
- Final presentation should be submitted in pdf format through the link provided on the website.
- A plagiarism report must be mandatorily submitted upon acceptance of the abstract to *srf.mcodsmr@manipal.edu*.

## **PARTICIPATION & CERTIFICATE**

- All authors to be present at the venue (for onsite delegates) or online meeting room (for online delegates) during the given time slot for interaction with the judges
- There is NO ORAL PRESENTATION for poster
- Poster will be judged for its visual appeal, accuracy, creativity and structure.
- All authors will receive credit on the same certificate.

# DEBATE COMPETITION

## GUIDELINES

### ELIGIBILITY & TEAM COMPOSITION:

- Participants must be undergraduate dental students from recognised institutions and must be registered for the conference.
- A maximum of two teams per college will be eligible to register
- Each team should include 2 registered delegates. (1 speaking for the topic & 1 speaking against the topic)

### RULES

- Participants will be allowed 5 minutes for presentation followed by a 2-minute Q&A session by the judges and the opponent teams.
- Topic will be given to participants 24 hours before the event.
- Decorum should be maintained; derogatory or foul language will lead to disqualification
- Judgement will be based on the anecdotes, examples, oratory skills and critical thinking abilities.

#### **SCOPE:**

Questions will be based on General knowledge and BDS undergraduate curriculum and clinically relevant dentistry, including Oral Anatomy & Histology, Physiology, Dental Materials, Microbiology, Oral Pathology, Pharmacology, General Medicine & Surgery (relevant to dentistry), Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics, Periodontology, Prosthodontics, Orthodontics, Oral Medicine & Radiology, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry, and Public Health Dentistry.

#### **ELIGIBILITY & TEAM COMPOSITION:**

- Participants must be undergraduate dental students from recognised institutions and must be registered for the conference.
