TITLE: Build Your Career in Research

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP :

The hands on workshop is divided into 2 parts:

- Part 1: The participant will engage in real world simulation of a healthcare corporate office where they will enact various research related roles in academic gameplay
- Part 2: Participants will get hands-on experience where they will build their resume and LinkedIn profile in real time;

All the participants will receive freebies, and winners will walk away with prizes. By the end of the session, students would have practised and built foundational career skills; not through lectures but by actually doing the work.

OBJECTIVES: By the end of workshop participants will be able to :

- Identify corporate healthcare career pathways in research beyond clinical practice, and understand how their research skills can be leveraged as a professional asset.
- They will leave with a functional LinkedIn profile and resume; ready for real-world use, along with the awareness and confidence to navigate the corporate healthcare and research space.
