The 3rd edition of the National Conference on Youth in Social Change was organized by Manipal Academy of Higher Education on 17th September 2022 at Manipal on the occasion of 87th Birthday of Dr Ramdas M Pai, Honourable Chancellor of MAHE. The aim of the conference was to encourage the concept of giving among the youth and to sensitize them towards bringing a social change. Dr Ranjan R Pai, President, MAHE Trust, Chairman, Manipal Education and Medical Group launched the event through a cultural element of Tulunaadu, wherin the pingara flowers signify growth and prosperity.

Lt. Gen. Dr. M D Venkatesh in his welcome address mentioned that "We are a young country and youngsters like you are the change makers of societal problem. MAHE focuses on serving the community through volunteerism. It has a sustainable volunteering engagement and has evolved a system over the years for academic volunteering in higher educations in India. Through volunteering student gain opportunities to meaningfully engage in community service that benefits the community and also instill a sense of civic and social responsibility within them.
